## TUITION:

Lesson fees (\$90 for four 30-minute lessons unless otherwise indicated) will be paid in advance every 4 weeks. *Any notification of withdrawal should be given 30 days in advance.*

Class fees are due 2 weeks before the first class meeting. Class tuition payment is a full semester commitment. See registration form for tuition amounts.

Checks should be made payable to First Baptist Church Hendersonville, with “SoFA” and student’s name in the reference line.

## ANNUAL ADMINISTRATION FEE:

A \$25 administration fee is payable with each registration and is due each year. There is a \$50 maximum per family.

## LESSON AND CLASS TIMES:

Available lesson times will vary depending on the schedule of each instructor. You will be contacted to set up the individual lesson time. All classes and lessons are scheduled Mondays-Thursdays at First Baptist Church Hendersonville.

## CURRICULUM:

Tuition does not cover the cost of materials. Classes have required supply fees in addition to the class tuition. Materials required for private lessons will be assigned by your instructor. It is your responsibility to obtain these materials. In some cases, the instructor may prefer to get the materials for you and be reimbursed.

## MISSED LESSONS:

Instructors are not obligated to schedule make-up lessons unless lessons are cancelled due to inclement weather, an unforeseen change in the instructor’s schedule, or an emergency. ***You are responsible for the tuition even if you do not attend the scheduled lesson.*** Make-up lessons are at the discretion of the instructor and only if advance arrangements (before the day of the lesson) are made. If a student must miss a lesson, please contact the instructor directly. This does not entitle the student to a make-up lesson.

**SNOW POLICY:**

If Sumner County Schools are closed due to inclement weather, ***you will be notified by the instructor or the School of Fine Arts if there will be no lessons or classes that evening.*** If the FBCH building has not been closed, it is possible the classes or lessons will be held as scheduled. It would be up to the instructor and/or parents to use their own discretion as to the road conditions in their areas to decide to cancel their lessons or not.

**SAFETY AND SECURITY:**

Parents, please be available to pick up your student at the end of the class/lesson. Instructors may not release students to find their way to the car.

Any siblings that may be in the building while students are taking lessons should be supervised by their parent or guardian at all times. They should not be roaming the hallways, other areas of the church, or other classrooms.
