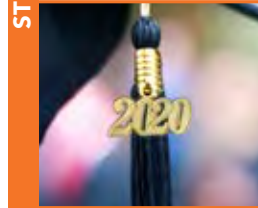
Memphis Missions Trip

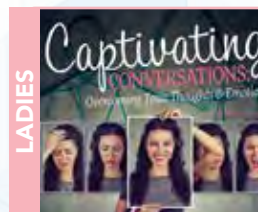
